Office Order

Disposal of Representations in pursuance to the judgment and order passed by Hon'ble High Court, Lucknow dated 24.2.2010

This is in furtherance of the Notice No. 111-113/2010-Ph.D. dated 6.3.2010.

In view of the judgment and order dated 24.2.2010 passed by Hon'ble High Court, Lucknow in Writ Petition No.907 of 2007 (M/S) "Mohan Chandra Dixit and others Versus Vice Chancellor Lucknow University", certain representations were received by the undersigned with regard to admission in Ph.D. in the Faculty of Law, Lucknow University. The matter was taken up at appropriate Forum of the University, deliberations were made and University rules/U.G.C. guidelines were looked into.

Now the undersigned would like to dispose of the representation with following observations/statement of the facts:-

1. That in pursuance of the University notification, several candidates including the petitioners applied for admissions on prescribed form and deposited the requisite fee etc. They appeared in the eligibility test and work/interview and were declared eligible for presentation before Departmental Research Committee (D.R.C.). The candidates who had qualified J.R.F./N.E.T. Examination conducted by the University Grant Commission (U.G.C.) were exempted from the test and interview. The test was conducted as per University rules/U.G.C. guidelines. However it is made clear here that this test was merely an eligibility test and candidates who obtained 50% (45% in case of S.C./S.T.) and above were declared eligible. Thus the candidates obtaining 50% (45% in case of S.C./S.T.) and above were treated eligible at par with those who had qualified J.R.F./NET conducted by U.G.C.
2. That during 22.9.2009 to 24.9.2009, a Committee of the senior Teachers of the Faculty of Law was convened to consider the
