## CONCEPT NOTE

*"Sanitation is more important than independence"*  
*Mahatma Gandhi*

Access to clean water and sanitation is a fundamental human right and essential to life, health and dignity. The United Nation believes that all the people should have access to adequate drinking water and sanitation facilities whether they stay in rural or urban areas. Provision of basic water supply and sanitation facilities to people is still a major concern for governments. Absence of these basic facilities leads to poor health and also affects the livelihood of the poor and vulnerable communities.

As per Census 2011, sanitation coverage in Uttar Pradesh is at 35.65%, i.e. 64.35 % (roughly two third) Households not having latrine facility within the premises and 63.04% of population is practicing open defecation in UP (77.13% Rural & 14.82% Urban). Most people depend (64.93%) on hand pumps for drinking water and only 27.26 % of people are covered under tap water services. Unequivocally, sanitation is a one key priority of the State Government as it evident from its clearly articulated political and administrative agenda.

The National Service Scheme, University of Lucknow and Water Aid North are taking in account the recent developments made by Government of India and State Government to upscale efforts for attaining a Clean India by 2<sup>nd</sup> October 2019 is making efforts to form an Alliance of Civil Society Organizations to drive the field implementation of sanitation programme in Uttar Pradesh. The idea is to forge a collaborative partnership in which all stakeholders make efforts in finding answers to critical challenges faced by the water sanitation and hygiene services improvement programme in Uttar Pradesh and take a proactive initiative to support the field implementation through concurrent monitoring feedback, research and documentation of success and failures for wider replication or taking effective course correction across the vast state of Uttar Pradesh.

The initiative aims to create a learning and sharing mechanism of Knowledge Networking and take forward the establishment of a State WASH forum titled "**Jal Evam Swacchata Manch – Uttar Pradesh**" to steer the implementation of national sanitation programme of Swacchh Bharat Mission and State Government initiative of Clean UP - Green UP Mission successful in Uttar Pradesh.

In this context, the National Service Scheme, University of Lucknow, Water Aid North, Vigyan Foundation and Other International Organizations are jointly organising a National Seminar on '**Civil Society Alliance for Upscaling Sanitation Efforts in Uttar Pradesh**' on 24<sup>th</sup>-25<sup>th</sup> March, 2015 at University of Lucknow.

## RATIONALE

The seminar aims to bring various stakeholders like academicians, policy planners, programme administrators, representatives of civil society, NGOs, media, social & development activists and practitioners to chalk out the strategies for upscaling efforts on sanitation.

## OBJECTIVES

- To critically examine situation of sanitation and knowledge gap between the community and service providers.
- To support government in achieving its goal of a open defecation free society through civil society organizations.
- Creation of a civil society platform to give impetus to WASH drive.

- ♦ Government & Civil society standpoint of both Centre and State in terms of policy and administration along with the implementing methodology.

- ♦ Knowledge gaps and behavioural reform strategies for changing mindsets of communities for

clean habits.

- ♦ Sanitation promotion with a special focus on communities living in rural, urban areas, Clean Schools, Working Places, Worship Places, Railway & Bus stations etc.
- ♦ WASH, Education, Media and Social Networking.
- ♦ Youth as changing agent for sanitation.
- ♦ Mechanisms for crystallization of 'Civil Society Alliance on WASH at the State level as State WASH forum through this platform.
- ♦ Collaborative partnerships for significant improvement in WASH services.
- ♦ Constitution of **Jal Evam Swacchata Manch – Uttar Pradesh** the Civil Society Alliance on WASH in Uttar Pradesh.
- ♦ Suggest measures for collaboration of government authorities with civil society.
