The issue of 'corruption' has raised many challenges worldwide in the process of sustainable development. Accomplishment of poverty-eradication and sustainability objectives has severely been affected by the growing corruption in the different societies and sectors. These issues are seen as major contributors to the global financial crisis, the fallout of which we are experiencing. We have also witnessed the impact on a few high profile companies as a result of ethical failures. Understanding of the corruption related issues is crucial for practitioners, as they greatly influence business practices.

Internal Quality Assurance Cell, University of Lucknow is consistently putting forward issues to enhance quality in education. In the same the present workshop is another step to induce a serious discussion to enhance standards of transparency in its regular working.
