Prof. Yash Pal will be in city to inaugurate the summer camp on 21st May with Prof. Manoj K Mishra, Vice- Chancellor of the University as Chairman. The University of Lucknow is executing a programme INSPIRE, initiated by the Dept. Science and Technology, Government of India, New Delhi during May 21- 25.

The programme includes lectures, interactions and face-to- face with about 2 dozen eminent scientists during the 5 days of the residential camp. They include several directors of the national laboratories of CSIR DST, and ICAR. There will also be many experts from IIT- Kanpur, IIT- Delhi, BSIP- Lucknow, SGPGI, central government departments and also Banaras and Lucknow universities. The range of topics to be covered has a wide range and includes physical, chemical, biological and earth sciences. Over 200 students selected from all over the state are congregating to experience the excitement of science. The selected students represent the brightest interested students from all the three boards and are selected strictly on merit of class X. The programme is a part of scheme to attract bright students to science by providing them an early exposure. The programme also includes science film shows, night sky watching and Yoga classes. The camp will be held at 'World Unity Convention', CMS Degree College, Kanpur Road.
