Tentative Last Chance for two year degree in B.Ed. course

As the last date (March 15, 2018) is approaching for B.Ed. Admission Test for year 2018-20 the aspirants for this course must be aware of the fact that:

- May be this is the last chance for availing this degree in two years.
- Since the National Council for Teachers Education (NCTE) has proposed a four years integrated B.Ed. Program from coming next year and government is concentrating on better and quality education and probably advertise large number of teaching post for the B.Ed. pass out in near future.
- This time Lucknow University has provided a hassle free and candidates friendly process for admission in B.Ed. course.
- After admission test, the successful candidates will get their result on internet through their personal login.
- Further they don't have to go to counselling centres for their admission and verification of their eligibility certificates regarding their category, income and weightage certificates.

The counselling process of JEE B.Ed. 2018 – 2020 is being simplified in the interest of students. Lucknow University is in the process in which candidates will not have to visit the counselling centres physically. The following changes are being proposed-

- Document verifications will be carried out online on the basis of the documents that are being uploaded by the candidate at the time of form filling.
- Candidate will have to register for counselling by paying counselling fees of Rs. 750.00 and advance college fees of Rs. 5000.00 at the time of choice filling through online modes viz. Netbanking/Debit and Credit cards only.
- As there are no provision of demand drafts and bank challan, the candidates would be required to submit their personal bank detail at the time of registration which should be in the name of the candidate or father or mother. If college is not allotted to the candidate, the advance college fee of Rs. 5000.00 will be refunded into their account.
- After allotment is complete candidates can deposit the seat confirmation fee (balance college fee) online too through Netbanking/Debit/Credit Cards.
