The event will comprise keynote/plenary talks, contributed talks, and poster sessions to provide you a premier interdisciplinary forum to present and discuss the most recent innovations, trends, concerns, practical challenges encountered and the solutions adopted in the field of fish parasitology.

About the Symposium

Contributing to the food and nutritional security, employment, tourism and above all foreign exchange, Indian fisheries and aquaculture sector have an important place in the Indian economy. Diseases caused by pathogenic organisms are, however, a major threat to both wild fish populations and the aquaculture industry incurring heavy economic losses. In fact, a few parasites of fish are capable of infecting humans too. The control of fish diseases can only be best achieved when the taxonomic identity and ecological requirements of parasites have been determined.

Therefore, the scientific program will include various research areas of fish Parasitology ranging from traditional taxonomic descriptions and faunal surveys, to molecular taxonomy to interactions between host-parasite systems and the environment, immunology and fish health management.

Presentations

Oral presentations in MS power point will be of 15 minutes while keynote talks will be of 30 minutes. The required dimensions of posters are 120 cm (height) by 90 cm (width) maximum (portrait shape).

Awards and certificates

All registered student delegates will receive certificate of participation/attendance. Student awards will be considered for both oral and poster presentations. All delegates of not more than 35 years as on the date of the symposium can apply for the student's award. A full-length research paper by the interested candidates is required to be submitted latest by 3rd of September 2018 to be considered for the awards.
