

Research Promotion Scheme

The research and development (R&D) is an integral and important part of the Universities. The University of Lucknow in its initiative of promoting quality research is coming up with a scheme of rewarding research scholars and faculty members involved in research activity.

1. For Research Scholars- A research scholar on the recommendation of his/her Supervisor & Head of department will be given a cash prize of Rs. 1100 for every paper published fulfilling following criterion:

- 1.1. In a journal listed in UGC approved journal list.
- 1.2. Journal impact parameter should be more than 1. (Impact factor will be considered from international agencies Thomas Reuter & Scopus).
- 1.3. In case of multi author paper only first author will be given reward.
- 1.4. The reward will be given for a particular academic session.

2.For Faculty Members- A Faculty Members on the recommendation of Head of department will be given a cash reward of Rs. 1100 for the papers published

- 2.1. In an international journal listed in UGC approved journal list.
- 2.2. if total impact parameter of Journals in which his/her papers/paper are published is more than 5 (Impact factor will be considered from international agencies Thomas Reuter & Scopus).
- 2.3. The reward will be given for a particular academic session.

3.Books- A Faculty Members on the recommendation of Head of department will be given a cash prize of Rs. 1100 for the book published by an international publisher.

The application through proper channel may be sent to IQAC office by September 15 of particular year along with following documents-

- i. Copy of research paper published

ii. UGC list no. of the Journal

iii. Proof of impact factor from above mentioned agencies

The award will be declared on by 25th Nov. after scrutiny of applications through a committee duly constituted by Hon'ble Vice Chancellor for this purpose.

4. Projects: The University will provide a grant of Rs. 10000 to a faculty member with proven good track record of research (at least 5 publications in last 3 years) with following conditions-

4.1. Faculty member has to submit a proposal for 1 year with following details:

i. Origin of problem

ii. objectives

iii. Methodology

iv. expected outcome

v. Deliverables

4.2. Half of the grant will be released after getting assessment report of an expert committee constituted by Hon'ble Vice Chancellor.

4.3. Rest of the grant will be released after submission of the final report and deliverables to IQAC office.

4.4. In case of limited number of slots Assistant professor will be preferred over Associate professors and professors.

5. Consultancy:

Consultancy services provided by university academic staff is one of the important component of R & D activities. It appears that due to lack of clear cut consultancy policy/ rules regarding remunerative consultancy on the part of University, a state of confusion prevails among faculty members, which discourage faculty members to provide consultancy services at institutional level.

Academic Staff may engage in up to 50 - 70 days per annum remunerated consultancy activities for third parties through the University after a formal approval from The Vice Chancellor and may retain remuneration received from consulting, subject to the conditions outlined below-

5.1 When consultancy is undertaken for any agency/ institute/ industry, the 40 % will be shared by concerned faculty and 60% has to be deposited to the University for General Welfare Activities.

5.2 In the case of Government agencies where the remuneration distribution rules are given, the funds generated will be distributed as per the rules of that particular Government agency.

5.3 No faculty member should be involved in any type of remunerative/non Remunerative consultancy without prior permission from the University

5.1 Lab consultancy:

Faculty members can engage students from other universities and institutions for lab related consultancy (summer training, project work etc.) for a limited period of time. The charges for such activity will be Rs. 5000/- per month and will be shared by University and faculty member in a ratio of 60% & 40% respectively.
