- Separate Java and C programming competition will be held.
- Students can participate in either one or both of the competitions.
- Two rounds:
  - Preliminary round: Written quiz (Elimination Round)
  - Final round: Computer based programming competition
- **Date and time:**
  1. **Preliminary round- 18/03/2020 at:**
    - a. **12:30 pm** onwards for C programming competition
    - b. **2:00 pm** onwards for Java programming competition
  2. **Final round- 20/03/2020 at 11:00 am** onwards

**Guidelines:**

- The paper of first round will consist of 60 questions.
- Participants will get a total of 90 minutes to attempt the paper.
- 4 marks will be awarded for each correct answer and 1 mark will be deducted for an incorrect answer.
- Participants must be carrying a blue and black ball point pen along with them.
- No electronic gadgets will be allowed in the exam hall.
- Students qualifying the preliminary round will be eligible for appearing in the system-based coding round thereafter.


**Note:** Participants are requested to report 30 minutes before the beginning of the event.


### Registration Process:
