- 4. The session will then dive into a general Q&A by attendees. The respective host (Eva) will pick certain questions from the chat box and those will be addressed.

The end of the session will be with feedback from our speakers and guests. The webinar shall last for approximately 1-1.5 hours.

Question and topics to be addressed in the webinar

- 2. Myths and taboos on menstruation in accordance with vaccination and Covid-19.
- 3. A short guide on menstrual products, which ones to use and which ones are recommended.
- 4. Diseases related to menstruation.
- 5. Nisha ma'am's encounter with the patients and what she generally observed lacks in period literacy.
