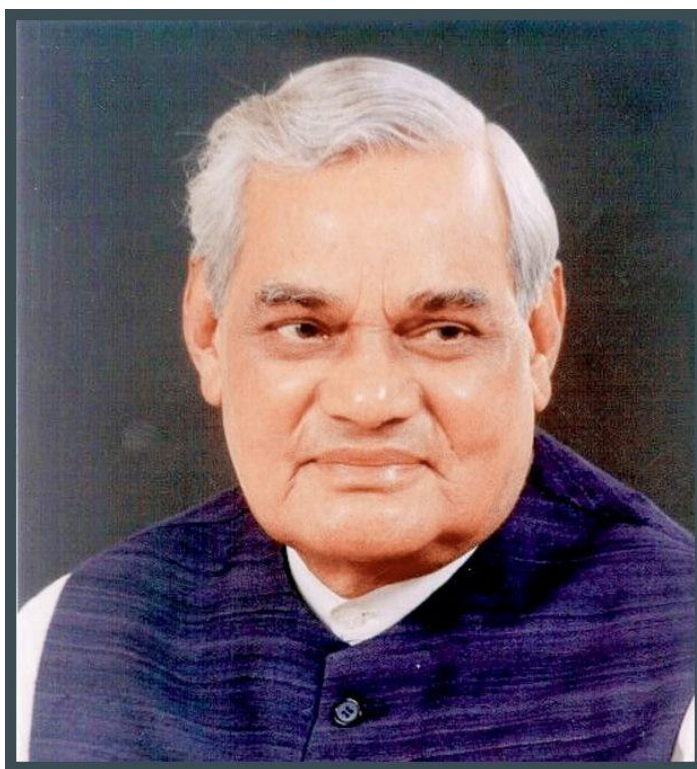

The COVID-19 has brought unprecedented challenges to societies and governments across the world, threatened humanity and global resilience and reversed the dividends of economic growth and development by pushing millions of people below poverty line.

In times of crisis such as the current COVID-19 pandemic and its economic and social repercussions, good governance matters more than ever. Governance arrangements have played a critical role in immediate responses by the governments across the world, and will continue to be crucial both to the recovery and to build a “New Normal” once the crisis subside.

From a health crisis, the Covid-19 pandemic has become a systemic global risk. The interconnected nature of COVID-19 pandemic crisis demands an integrated approach and coordinated action, which complicates decision making even more. Identifying the best set of policies and instruments to address COVID-19 challenges and aligning them with broader social goals will be critically important for sustainable recovery from the pandemic. The key practical challenges for the governments are how to formulate and prioritize policies to achieve the interconnected goals of managing health crisis, recovering the economy, bridging the trust deficit and achieving environmental sustainability.

The Seminar is therefore, aimed at bringing together academicians, practitioners, researchers and professionals to share their findings and experiences on the topic and to take stock of responses to COVID-19 and developing analysis and recommendations on a range of public governance topics. The recommendations and suggestions may help governments tackle the crisis and plan for sustainable recovery.
