**EXPLANATORY NOTE
ON NEP (BA/B.Sc/B.Com)
EVALUATION AND GRADING**

1. Evaluation of student performance in each paper has two components: (i) Internal continuous assessment and (ii) End-Semester examination.
2. The level of student academic performance as the aggregate of continuous assessment and end-semester examination is reflected as letter grades on a ten point scale according to the following table:
3. A candidate may be awarded grace marks upto a maximum of 07 marks as per rules.

Marks obtained (out of 100)	Letter Grade	Numeric value of grade or Grade Point
Greater than or equal to 85	A+	8.5 to 10.0
Less than 85 but greater than or equal to 70	A	7.0 to 8.5
Less than 70 but greater than or equal to 60	B+	6.0 to 7.0
Less than 60 but greater than or equal to 55	B	5.5 to 6.0
Less than 55 but greater than or equal to 50	C	5.0 to 5.5
Less than 50 but greater than or equal to 40	D	4.0 to 5.0
Less than 40 but greater than or equal to 33	P	3.3 to 4.0
Less than 33	F	0
Absent	Ab	0

4. For Non Credit/Foundation courses 'Satisfactory' (Grades 'P' to 'O') or 'Unsatisfactory' (Grade 'F' or 'Ab') is indicated instead of the letter grade and this is not counted for the computation of SGPA/CGPA.
5. The Semester Grade Point Average (SGPA) and Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA) are computed as follows:

- a) The SGPA is a weighted average of the grade points earned by a student in all the Papers accredited and describes his/her academic performance in a Semester. If the grade points associated with the letter grades awarded to a student are $G_1, G_2, G_3, \dots, G_n$ in n Papers and the corresponding credits of the Papers are $C_1, C_2, C_3, \dots, C_n$ the SGPA is given by:

$$SGPA = \frac{G_1C_1 + G_2C_2 + \dots + G_nC_n}{C_1 + C_2 + \dots + C_n}$$

- b) The CGPA indicates the overall academic performance of a student in all the papers registered upto and including the latest completed semester term. It is computed in the following way:

$$CGPA = \frac{SGPA_1 + SGPA_2 + SGPA_3 + \dots + SGPA_n}{n}$$

6. The obtained marks in each paper is reflected with the grade point in the marksheet of the candidate.
7. The candidate shall be declared passed in each theory paper, he/she secure 33% marks (25 marks) in paper and in aggregate, he/she secure 36% marks (216).
8. Award of Division:
 - (a) First Division : 60.00% and above
 - (b) Second Division: 49.00 to 59%
 - (c) Third Division: 33.00 to 48%
