







ABOUT THE DEPARTMENT

The University of Lucknow, realizing the importance of the study of Public Administration, started a post-graduate Diploma Course in Public Administration in 1943 under the Department of Political Science and after Independence set up, in 1955, the Institute of Public Administration with the help of the Technical Cooperation Mission of U.S.A. Subsequently, course of Master's degree in Public Administration was started in July 1959 in the Department of Political Science. In 1963, an independent Department of Public Administration was created with responsibility for teaching and research in Public Administration. A pioneering institution in the country and one of the few to provide teaching, training and research in Public Administration the Department has since its inception been running, Masters Programmes and Diplomas in Public Administration and related fields.

The Department has a long tradition of providing training, both induction and in-service, to government officials of different levels on various aspects of Public Administration. It is a pioneering institution in northern India, particularly in Uttar Pradesh, where teaching, research and training in public administration and information management is provided. The Department also undertakes evaluation of various government programmes and also provides consultancy. It has well-established international linkages with an exchange of scholars for higher training and research. It also has the distinction of being the first Department in India for providing courses in Public Administration to senior teachers of the country.

ABOUT THE ATAL SUSHASAN PEETH

Atal Sushasan Peeth, established by the Department Of higher education, Government of Uttar Pradesh in memory of former Prime Minister Atal Bihari Vajpayee, aims to promote research and initiatives in the realm of good governance. Officially inaugurated after approval from Lucknow University's Executive Council in March 2020, the chair focuses on various objectives including conducting research on governance principles and Vajpayee ji's ideas, analysing administrative practices, and publishing his speeches and writings. Additionally, it organizes lecture series and seminars on leadership and governance topics, conducts training/workshops programs, and collaborates with institutions at global, national, and regional levels to further research in the field.
