CHANCELLOR'S MEDALS

Regulations relating to the Award of the
"Chancellor's Medal"

Ten Bronze Medals, two Silver Medals and one Gold Medal shall be awarded annually bearing the words "The Chancellor's Medal awarded to....." in the year on the one side and the words "Lucknow University" on the other with the University Common Seal.

Bronze Medals

Two Bronze Medals shall be awarded to the best students reading in the Final Year of a Bachelor Degree Course in each Faculty of the University.

Silver Medals

One Silver Medal shall be awarded to the best student among all the student of all the Faculties in Post-Graduate Classes.

One Silver Medal shall be awarded to the best women student of the University.

Gold Medals

One Gold Medal shall be awarded to the best student in all the Faculties.

A Committee consisting of the following will advise the Vice-Chancellor in the Selection of suitable candidates:

(i) The Deans of Faculties

(ii) The Provosts of Halls

(iii) The Proctor

(iv) The Chairman, Lucknow University Athletic Association and the President, King George's Medical College Athletic Association.

In making the Selection, the Vice-Chancellor will take into consideration of the following basis:

- (i) The merit of the student as judged by this entire academic record especially the position in the last Examination, quality work in class during the year to which the award pertains and regularity in studies. The award will be made preferably to student getting Ist Class marks and in no case getting less than 50% marks in the last examination.
- (ii) Physical fitness, games played and distinctions obtained in the general health and membership of N.C.C. other Corps such as Land Army and recreation etc.
- (iii) Discipline as Judged by manner observance of rules inside and outside the University, behaviour conducive to well regulated life of the University.
- (iv) Participation in collective constructive activity on behalf of the University.

The names of the medalists shall be published in the Calendar.
