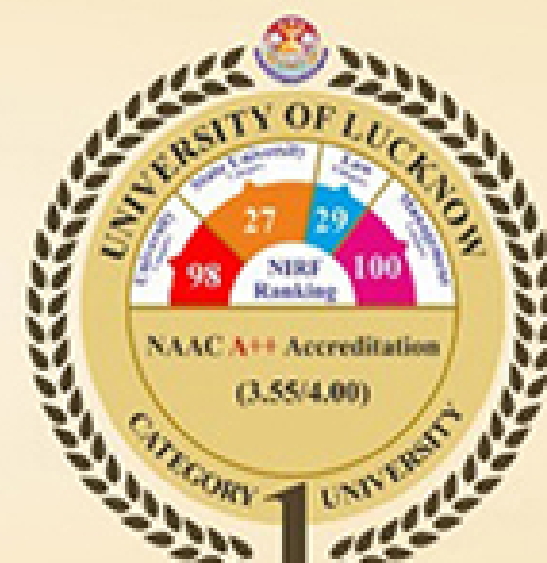

ADMISSIONS TO 954 PHD SEATS BEGIN AT LU

LUCKNOW: Admissions for PhD courses for the academic session 2025-26 were announced by Lucknow University on Wednesday. The online applications can be filled from Thursday onwards online through the Samarth portal on the Lucknow University website, www.lkouniv.ac.in. The deadline for applications is February 21.

The university advertised 954 seats in 42 subjects for admission to regular PhD courses while 61 seats for Part Time PhD courses in 20 subjects. The application fee is Rs. 2000/- for General, OBC, EWS candidates and Rs. 1000/- for SC, ST and PwD category candidates.

In addition, PhD seats have been announced in several other disciplines, including Management Studies (MBA), Library and Information Science, Journalism and Mass Communication, Fine Arts, French, and Urdu.

Admissions to PhD to open on Friday

Lucknow: After a wait of almost a year, Lucknow University invited online applications for admission to its PhD courses for academic session 2025-2026. The admission window will open on Friday. Interested candidates may fill in the form online through Samarth portal on the Lucknow University website, www.lkouniv.ac.in. Last date for application to PhD programme is Feb 21. PhD admissions will be for 954 seats in LU and affiliated colleges and admissions, of which 454 seats are in LU.

There are 103 PhD seats in chemistry, the highest number, of which, 17 are at LU. In LU, maximum PhD seats are in political science and admissions will be on 55 seats, while in affiliated colleges, highest number of seats, 52, is offered in sociology.

"Admissions to 2025-26 PhD programme are offered for Regular and Part-Time PhD programmes. LU is offering admission to Regular PhD courses for 954 seats in 42 subjects in LU and its affiliated colleges, while for Part-Time PhD, admissions will be on 61 seats in 20 subjects," said Mukul Srivastava, LU spokesperson.

Aesthetics, Shaiva ideals to be part of course

Lucknow: Lucknow University is set to introduce new academic programmes in aesthetics and Shaiva philosophy, expanding interdisciplinary and classical knowledge studies. The decision was taken following instructions issued by Vice Chancellor Prof J P Saini. New programmes will be offered under the Abhinavagupta Institute of Aesthetics and Shaiva Philosophy. At present, the department is engaged in preparing detailed syllabus and academic framework for the courses. The programmes are expected to commence from the upcoming academic session. The Abhinavagupta Institute, established in 1968, has primarily functioned as a research centre for decades.

With the introduction of new courses, the institute will now take on a more active academic role, enabling structured teaching in areas such as aesthetics, Shaiva thought and related philosophical traditions.

Dean of Abhinavagupta Institute of Aesthetics and Shaiva Philosophy, Bhuvneshwari Bhardwaj, said, "Planning for new programmes is underway. The institute is exploring vocational courses, postgraduate programmes and diploma options, with strong emphasis on research."
