Press Release of the Workshop by Legal Aid Centre

Gender Sensitization Workshop by Legal Aid Centre and ICC of University Of Lucknow at Faculty of Yoga and Alternative Medicine.

Legal Aid Centre, University Of Lucknow in collaboration with Internal Complaints Committee, University Of Lucknow, successfully conducted the workshop based on the theme "Gender Sensitization" at the Faculty Of Yoga and Alternative Medicine, New Campus, University Of Lucknow on 7th May, 2022 under the guidance of Prof. (Dr.) CP Singh (Head & Dean, Faculty Of Law) and Prof. (Dr.) Mohmmad Ahamad (Chairperson, Legal Aid Centre) and Prof. Madhurima Pradhan, Chairperson (Internal Complaint Committee, University of Lucknow).

The workshops are frequently conducted by the Centre under its motto of "Equal Access To Justice". And in continuation with this, it was the second workshop of the Phase - I.

Members of the Legal Aid Centre commenced the session with hearty Kulgeet of the University. The programmed was divided into two parts: the first part covered numerous laws now in effect in the society, and the second part covered specifically the Prevention of Sexual Harassment of Women at Workplace (Prevention, Prohibition, and Redressal) Act, 2013.

The programmed began with the screening of instructive and powerful videos on gender sensitization. Transgender and LGBTQ+ communities' societal isolation was also discussed.

Equal Remuneration Act 1976, Hindu Succession Act (2005), Maternity Benefits Bill, 2018 were introduced in brief. The workshop was a great success, interaction with students and noting their views as feedback was also done. The members of Legal Aid Centre explained Sexual Harassment of Women at Workplace (Prevention, Prohibition, Redressal) Act 2013 and its technicalities such as definition of ICC, LCC and also how to file a complaint with illustrations making it more interactive. Women were also awarded about the unsafe workplace environment, the case of Bhawri Devi and hardship faced by them to file a complaint.

The session was presided over by Prof. (Dr.) Amar Kumar Tiwari, Member of Internal Complaints Committee (ICC), University of Lucknow, Acharya Krishna Kumar Shukla of Faculty of Yoga and Alternative Medicine, and Mr. Umesh Kumar Shukla.
