POSH Program at Hindi Department

A POSH workshop was organized by Internal Complaints Committee, University of Lucknow in Department of Hindi on 3rd December, 2021 at 11:00 am. The program started with lighting of lamp by Prof. Madhurima Pradhan, Chairperson Internal Complaint Committee, Dr.Y.P. Singh, Head Hindi Department, Dr. Krishna Ji Srivastava and the resource person Dr. Sanchita Ghatak. Dr. Y.P. Singh welcomed the guests and emphasized upon the status of women in ancient Indian society. Prof. Madhurima Pradhan highlighted the role and responsibilities of Internal Complaint Committee and the need of conducting gender sensitization workshops for creating a conducive environment at workplace.
