



**REPORT- ESSAY COMPETITION ON INDIA- USA RELATIONSHIP:**

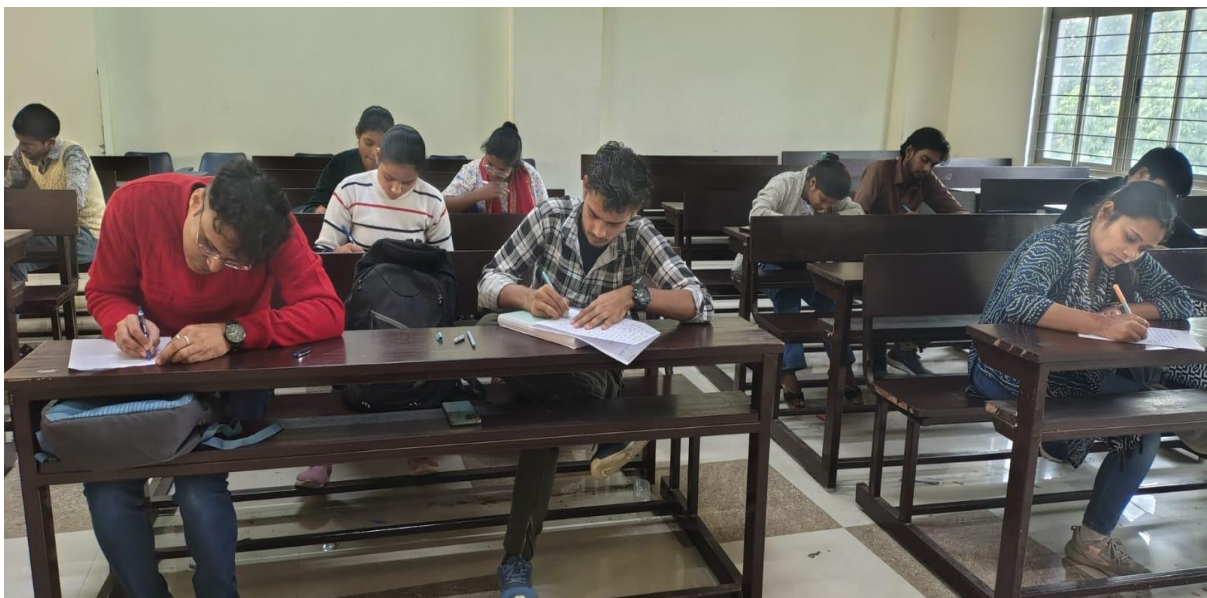
