### Narratives of Transformation: Social Change, Literature and Governance

The Counselling & Guidance Cell (CGC) and Happy Thinking Laboratory (HTL), University of Lucknow, in collaboration with the Department of English & M.E.L., successfully organized a two-day National Seminar on “Narratives of Transformation: Social Change, Literature and Governance” on 9 and 10 December 2025 at the Happy Thinking Laboratory, ONGC Building, University of Lucknow. The seminar aimed to provide an interdisciplinary academic platform to explore the interconnections between social change, literary narratives, and governance structures.

The seminar was organized under the Chief Patronage of Prof. Manuka Khanna, Hon’ble Vice-Chancellor, University of Lucknow. Prof. Arvind Mohan, Dean, Faculty of Arts, University of Lucknow, graced the occasion as the Guest of Honour. Eminent scholars including Prof. Rajesh Mishra, renowned sociologist, and Prof. Vikas Sharma, CCS University, Meerut, participated as Guest Speakers, enriching the deliberations with their scholarly insights.

## Day One: 9 December 2025 (Offline Mode)

The first day of the seminar began with the registration of participants, followed by the arrival of the distinguished guests. Post-lunch, the academic proceedings resumed with an insightful and thought-provoking address by Prof. Rajesh Mishra, Eminent Sociologist, who offered meaningful academic guidance and shared critical perspectives on issues of social transformation, governance, and intellectual engagement. His address was followed by an interactive question-and-answer session, during which participants actively engaged with the speaker, raising pertinent queries and sharing scholarly reflections. Subsequently, the seminar proceeded with four offline technical sessions, organized in two slots, focusing on paper presentations. The sessions were chaired by Prof. Vaishali Saxena, Prof. R. P. Singh, Prof. Rajesh Mishra, and Prof. M.

Priyadarshini, whose scholarly guidance and expertise significantly enriched the academic deliberations. Scholars and researchers from various universities and institutions presented papers on diverse sub-themes related to social change, literary discourse, cultural narratives, and governance challenges.



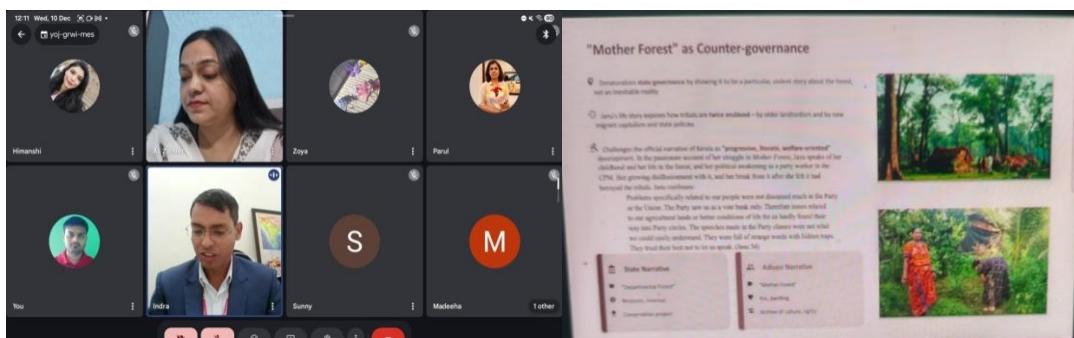
