Managing Teaching Learning

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 I. K. Devies has given the concept of managing teaching learning as content of teaching technology

In managing teaching learning, the content of any concept is divided into four steps. These steps are as follow-

1. Planning of Teaching

 It is first stage of any teaching event, in which teacher try to identify the objectives of the teaching in behavioural term. Teacher fixes the content of teaching through analysis and selection of appropriate teaching aids, methods and feedback devices.

2. Organising of Teaching

 It is second step of content in which teacher arrange or organise all components of content in the light of maxims of teaching in such a way that it may lead in smooth process.

3. Leading of Teaching

 The third step is leading stage, in which the teacher try to present the content of teaching with helps of teaching aids and strategies by generating harmonious environment for the objectives already decided in planning stage. The teacher also uses different feedback techniques to lead the students.

4. Controlling of Teaching

 This is the forth or last step of content for teaching technology. In this stage, teacher use different techniques of evaluation references of the objectives decided in planning stage for teaching. After evaluation teacher not only interpret the level achievement but also he can make any decision for modification at any stage to improve the entire structure or system of teaching and learning.
