Parts of Speech-(Verb)

- A verb consists of more than one word; as,
 - 1. The boys were playing.
 - 2. He has learnt his speech.

Kinds of Verb:

- 1. Transitive Verb
- 2. Intransitive Verb

Transitive verbs structure:

Subject+ verb+ object

Intransitive Verb:

Subject+ verb

Examples:

- 1. She spoke the truth.(Transitive)
- 2. She spoke haughtily. (Intransitive)
