









Special Lectures at IMS

Gender Sensitization in the Workplace

February 6th, 2020

As part of the Centenary Celebrations, a special lecture series was organised on 6th February 2020 at IMS. *Prof. Usha Kiran Rai*, professor of Marketing at FMS, BHU delivered a lecture on the topic '*Gender Sensitization in the Workplace*'. Prof. Usha Kiran Rai started her lecture with a practical example of lack of gender sensitivity. It is not about men or women. Men need to become a little more sensitized towards women and vice-versa. This is something which needs to be put in place since childhood. Girls are given the training to be sub-

missive while boys are appreciated for being aggressive. Girls are biologically unequal to men, and if this fact is not understood, it can lead to repercussions for the girl. What is needed is Equity of opportunities. There has to be an awareness of our behavior, words and actions in presence and about the other gender. If gender sensitization is ingrained in the child from an early age, there will be a change in the society.

It was an enlightening lecture for the audience and new insights in behaviour patterns were gained.

He suggested the students access Google IO series, talk by Vineet Nayyar 'HR would be dead by 2020', Deepak Malhotra lectures, which will add value to

their knowledge base. He said it is important to watch not just the content but to go behind the scenes and connect with the branding and marketing intended in it.

Giving students food for thought, Prof. Kaushik threw questions related to what kind of career plans students had, how many attended conferences, how many were serious about getting a job. He emphasized the role of Institute as being training and facilitation center rather than a placement giving agency.

Open Mic on Entrepreneurial Avenues

February 11th, 2020

Institute Management Sciences organized an *Open Mic* with *Mr. Sarvesh Goel*, Chairman of *GD Goenka Public School*. Mr. Goenka is a well known educationist, entrepreneur, activist and philanthropist. An alumus of the University of Lucknow, he shared his experiences while charting the path of entrepreneurship with the students as well as the contribution of the University of Lucknow in shaping his early life.

He talked about his journey from the very beginning to the establishment of GD Goenka Public

School. "When you start a business you have to play all the roles pertaining to the running of business, you have to be the owner and the employee at the same time" stressed Mr. Goel. He discussed about the entrepreneurial caliber, what does it takes from the start of a venture on our own to forming core team behind that business with the same vision. He gave his own mantras of running business by always keeping product quality over profit and second ensuring there should be no ego in business. It was an enlightening session for the students.

Personnel Management with Special Reference to Police Department February 27th, 2020

President's police medal awardee, *Mr. K.L. Gupta, Retd. Director General of Police Uttar Pradesh* delivered a speech and shared some valuable lessons from his prior experiences. He emphasized the importance of 'element of surprise' as well as 'learning from the grassroots' to become a successful leader. Citing examples where he used the 'element of surprise' to check the efficiency and working of the police constables, he guided the students on how to use surprise for their benefit. He talked at length about the importance of learning the basics in any job. An officer can be a successful

and humane leader only if he has experienced first hand the challenges and work scenario of his frontline workers.

The students listened to him with keen interest and also asked questions related to the commissionerate system of policing recently adopted by the Uttar Pradesh government, filing of complaints, policing and efficient traffic management protocols. Mr. Gupta explained the difference between the 'Dual system of Control' as it was existing till recent times and the newly approved system of Unified Command under the Commissionerate system.

Entrepreneurial Challenges for Management Graduates January 25th, 2020

A special lecture on 'Entrepreneurial Challenges for Management Graduates' with Mr. Anand P Srivastava, General Manager of Credit Vertical at SIDBI's Head Office, Lucknow was organised at IMS.

Mr. Srivastava talked about the increasing relevance of entrepreneurship in India, how a fresh graduate can go about setting up his own enterprise, what challenges await him, what support systems are available and what are the critical success factors that can help him succeed. Throwing light on the start-ups in the last 5 years, he told that since 2014 start-ups have collectively raised \$50 million, 3750 deals have been signed, have created 7,50,000 jobs and India today is home to the third largest start-up system after US and China.

Elaborating on who could be an entrepreneur, he emphasised four basic traits viz. A burning desire to make one's mark, risk taking ability, independence and self-confidence. He talked at length about the 5 challenges likely to be face by a

budding entrepreneur which are (i) Idea, (ii) knowledge (iii) permissions (iv) handholding and (v) capital. Concluding the lecture, he gave the students some success mantras to become a successful entrepreneur and also the CHICK principle i.e. Clarity, Honesty, Idea, Courage and Knowledge

An impressive resume or CV is the first communication between a applicant and employer. Keeping this in mind a *CV designing Workshop* was conducted by *Dr. Damini Saini* for the final year MBA students of IMS. She emphasized the importance of a CV as a personal branding document and hence discussed various formats, types of fonts to be used and colour schemes which can preferably be used. Stress Management and Spirituality

February 3rd, 2020

Bramhakumari Gopi Patel, who is an experienced meditation practitioner and a spiritual educator discussed the three important causes of stress in modern life: availability of too many options, increasing pace of life and the intrinsic need to control the circumstances of an individual. February 14th, 2020



Infrastructural Facilities at IMS


