LUCC PARAMARSH team under the dynamic leadership of Dr. Ritu Narang held a virtual meeting with the teachers of Faculty of Law to discuss and deliberate upon the issues of consultancy in the field of law. This meet was held as an icebreaking session to know about the potential areas of consultancy of the Law teachers. The meeting was held on ZOOM platform (zoom id - 89751566865) at 6:00 pm on 08/06/2021.

Dr. Ritu Narang, Director apprised the faculty members about the Consultancy Policy 2020 and the role of LUCC PARAMARSH. In this session, she explained the vision and *modus operandi* of PARAMARSH with the help of power point presentation. She was joined by other LUCC team members namely, Dr. M.K. Jain (Additional Director), Dr. Nishant Kumar, Dr. Anupma Singh, Dr. Puneet Mishra, Dr. Ashish Kumar Srivastava, Dr. Ranvijay Pratap Singh, Dr. Geetika T. Kapoor and Ms. Sidra, a student representative.

Director LUCC informed the house about the potential benefits of consultancy work and role that can be played by the Faculty of Law. She elaborated that consultancy can enhance the skillset of faculty members exponentially apart from fetching additional revenues for the University and Faculty. Consultancy work can help immensely in building University brand and bring laurels to University for its collaborative associations with potential clients where University and its client both will be in a win-win situation and mutually gain from each other.

After this brief presentation, she invited the faculty members to present their ideas, views and opinions for bringing in consultancy projects. Prof. C.P. Singh apprised the LUCC team about the kind of consultancy work especially in the area of family law that can be done by the Legal Aid Clinic. He said that faculty has huge potential to provide consultancy in different areas of laws. Professor Singh shared his vision about setting up the Arbitration Centre wherein Amicable Dispute Settlement can be done.

Dr. Satish Chandra informed the house about his domain area namely, Cyber Law, Tort & Consumer Protection. Dr. Richa Saxena drew attention of the house towards huge potential of faculty in the areas of labour issues and how University can associate itself with Government departments and PSUs. She undertook the responsibility to draft a proposal and prepare a short video on this and send it to LUCC.
