# UNIVERSITY OF LUCKNOW Guidelines for Admission to Part-time PhD Programme 2020-21

The merit list of the candidates shall be prepared on the basis of the following components:

S.No.	Component	Weightage
1.	Research plan write up of (approximately) 1000 words	70 marks
2.	Work Experience	10 marks
3.	Academic Index	10 marks
4.	Interview	10 marks
4.	TOTAL	100 marks

# Research Plan writeup:

All candidates shall be invited to the University and will be required to prepare a Research Plan write up of approximately 1000 words in a given time frame of 90 minutes (1½ Hours) and would be evaluated out of 70 marks which should consist of Introduction to the Topic, Proposed Research Method (Purpose of the Research, Research Objectives, Research Design, Data Collection Plan, Data Analysis Method) and Dissemination of Research Findings.

# Scoring of work experience:

The scoring of work experience shall be at 1mark for every year of whole-time work experience, in excess of five years, subject to a maximum of 10 marks.

#### Academic Index:

The academic index shall be calculated as per the following table:

### Interview:

All candidates shall be required to appear for an interview and the performance evaluated out of 10 marks.

## Evaluation of Research Plan Write up and Interview:

The DRC will jointly evaluate the Research Plan write up and performance in the Interview. The constitution of the DRC shall be as per section 8.1 (a) of the PhD Ordinances 2020 as follows:

- a) Head of the Department Chairperson -
- b) All members of the Board of Studies .
- c) All proposed supervisors,
- d) SC/ST and OBC representatives as observers nominated by the HOD (if no member of DRC belongs to the respective category).

**Short listing of Candidates:** 

The Department Research Committee shall prepare category wise merit lists (as per the seat matrix provided by the Admission Cell) on the basis of the combined scores and propose the names of shortlisted scholars (a maximum of three times the declared number of seats). The Head shall forward to the Vice-Chancellor through the Dean/ Coordinator Admissions the list of shortlisted candidates for final approval.
