



MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

and

University of Lucknow, Lucknow, Uttar Pradesh (henceforth called LU). LU founded in the year 1921 is one of the prominent educational institution which is located Awadh Region of Uttar Pradesh state. LU is proud of imparting the best education in more than 100 of Undergraduate and Postgraduate subjects in Arts, Science, Commerce, Business Administration, Computer Applications and so on against minimum amount of fee in the city.

Students For Seva (henceforth called **SFS**) is voluntary organization working in field community revises and social work utilising work force and motivation of students of colleges and universities.

Purpose: The Purpose of this Memorandum of Understanding is to establish and maintain an effective working relationship between the parties. The purpose is also to provide the means by which the LU and the SFS will and coordinate services to the Society for various social work-related activities.

Term: The term of the Memorandum of Understanding shallcommence from date of signature and shall extend two years from signature, but it is renewable thereafter from year to year unless either party gives notice of termination as provided herein.

Finance: No financial liability shall be in part of university of Lucknow for any activity carried out under the MoU.

This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) sets out the principles for collaborative activity, planning and service for deprived Communities in Bundelkhand Region of Uttar Pradesh. The MoU also attempts to follow principal of 'By the students, for the Society' for all activities. The students of National Service Scheme (NSS) of LU and its affiliated colleges shall participate and coordinate with SFS Students for all activities planned under MoU. LU and SFS shall work together for above purposes as and when requested by either party. It shall include community services and social work-related activities in following fields:

- Water conservation efforts including Rain Water Harvesting, Roof Top Rain Water Harvesting etc in areas of water stress in Awadh Region of Uttar Pradesh.
- 2. Cleaning of water bodies in the city and rural areas along Riversand other parts of the districts.
- Testing for potable water, underground water, tap water, river water at various places and sensitize nearby population regarding water contaminant present in water source and measures to reduce same.
- 4. Setting up of Vacation Employment Bureau for unemployed students for short/small jobs and works.
- 5. Identify and work with blind students for assistance in academic activities. To identify pool of students who can assist blind students as writers in exams.
- 6. To set up 'Book Bank' and 'Instrument Bank' with assistance of passing out students for distribution among needy children's.

- 7. Set up of 'Career Guidance Cell' for 12th standard students who need assistance in career counselling.
- 8. Students for Students free coaching class for various subjects and classes.
- Tree plantation drives in tree deficit areas and open spaces.
 Motivational activities among rural and urban communities for tree plantation and nature conservation.
- To identify Government welfare schemes for students and other citizens. To run awareness drive for the same amongpeople and students of schools, colleges and university.
- 11. Preparation and execution for plan of action for Students with Learning disability /Autistic/ Dumb, Deaf, Blind and orphan students in Bundelkhand Region of Uttar Pradesh.
- 12. Train and deploy students as a social worker in Government (Civil) Hospitals to help rural, illiterate patients in various hospital related quarries and assistance.
- 13. Collection of blankets, food, medicines, cloths and Distribution of same to poor and needy population.
- 14. To tie-up with doctors for Free Medical Check-up Camps for rural and urban poor in Region.
- 15. To identify and help old aged people staying alone for their assistance and help.
- 16. Any other social service-related activity as agreed uponboth the parties.
