
Report on Daily Gītā Pāṭh and Artha Session - University of Lucknow

Report on the First Model G20 Summit – University of Lucknow

Model G20 Summit at Lucknow University: 42 delegates from 21 countries propose creation of AI regulatory body

Lucknow University hosted the first-ever two-day Model G-20 Summit. Forty-two delegates from 21 countries and members of more than 10 international press corps attended the summit.

The conference discussed issues such as global trade and tariff structures, the challenges of artificial intelligence, and the future of the digital economy. Delegates presented their countries' positions and sought to build consensus.

Provide equal opportunities to developing countries

The conference passed a resolution to establish a global regulatory body on AI. This body would set ethical standards and provide equal opportunities to developing countries, while also working to prevent the misuse of AI. Delegates suggested promoting fair trade and improving tariff structures. Emphasis was placed on narrowing the digital divide between developed and developing countries.

A proposal for global cooperation on cybersecurity and data protection was put forward. In the closing session, China received the Best Country Delegation award. Ayush Shukla and Manya Srivastava represented China. Amarkant Sharma, Arya Sharma, and Mudit Mehrotra were selected as the best delegates. Deepti Singh, Kisalay Johri, and Abhigyan Pandey received the Best International Press award.
