Established in 2020, the Gender Sensitization Cell (GenSen) at the University of Lucknow champions a zero-tolerance policy against gender-based violence and discrimination. Under the leadership of Prof. Roli Misra, from Department of Economics, it comprises of faculty from Economics, Philosophy, Law, and English, the cell conducts workshops, interactive training, legal-literacy programs, and awareness campaigns in collaboration with Legal Aid Centre of University. It also promotes student-led outreach through 'Nukkad Nataks' (street plays) and the popular cultural series "Spaces," which uses music, poetry, and open dialogue to challenge gender violence and patriarchal norms. Practical initiatives include installing sanitary-napkin vending machines and publishing educational resources and event reports such as "Towards Inclusivity," symposiums on Asian Parliamentary Debate, and events marking International Women's Day. The cell also gives training to Judicial officers of family high courts, counsellors of Hon'ble High Court Allahabad. Also the cell has promoted inclusivity in associated colleges of University of Lucknow like IT college. AGDC, Navyug kanya mahavidyalaya, Y.D College, Lakhimpur etc. Through these diverse efforts, GenSen empowers the university community to challenge stereotypes, drive legal and cultural change, and foster a safer, inclusive campus.
